Roles & Responsibilities

To advise and make recommendations to Council on:

- Identifying cultural activities, <u>events</u> and engagements encouraging community participation;
- Obtaining artwork depicting local diverse talents and landmarks in addition to the unique features of the Town of Tecumseh, preserving the Town's various histories in the former municipalities of the Town of Tecumseh, Village of St. Clair Beach and Township of Sandwich South, and capturing the essence and spirit of the amalgamated Town;
- Identifying prominent locations within the Town of Tecumseh for public display of artwork; and
- Researching grants and acquire donations for achieving such goals; and
- <u>Consulting on storyboards.</u>

Composition

The Committee is comprised of one (1) to two (2) members of Council and five (5) or more members from the community.

The Chairperson and Vice-Chairperson are elected annually by members of the committee.

Meetings

The meetings of the Committee are held on the third Monday of each month at 7:00 pm in the Sandwich South Room of the Tecumseh Town Hall.

Department Responsible

The Corporate Services & Clerks department will be responsible for overseeing the Cultural & Arts Advisory Committee.
