Subject: Committee Appointments - 2020

Recommendations

It is recommended:

That all applications to the Senior Advisory, Cultural & Arts Advisory and the Heritage Committees **be accepted**;

And that the applications for the Committee of Adjustment **be considered** and direction provided on the preferred applicant to be appointed to the Committee of Adjustment;

And further that the term of these Committee appointments be for the remaining term of Council, ending November 14, 2022, or until such time as new members are appointed;

And furthermore that applicants be notified of Council's decision and by-laws be prepared to formally appoint the new members to these Committees at the next meeting of Council.

Background

The Committee/Local Board Application and Appointment Policy No. 4 (Policy) establishes timelines for calling and receiving applications for Committees/Local Boards and a process for reviewing the applications, as well as selecting persons to be appointed to the respective Committees/Local Boards.

The term of all Committees, the Business Improvement Area (BIA) Board and the Tecumseh Police Services Board appointments are consistent with the term of the Council that has appointed the Members.

Committee Appointments - 2020

The Policy requires that applications for appointments to **fill vacancies** that may occur for any Committee or Local Board in a non-election year be called in September by the Clerk.

At the August 13, 2019, Regular Meeting of Council, the Members gave consideration to CS-2019-20 regarding the 2020 Call for Applications for Advisory and Statutory Committees (Report).

As indicated in the Report, the only Committee for which there is currently a vacancy is the Committee of Adjustment. This vacancy is temporarily being filled by Councilor Bill Altenhof until such time as a new member is appointed. At the Meeting, direction was given, however, to include the following Committees in the 2020 Call for Applications.

- Committee of Adjustment;
- Tecumseh Accessibility Advisory Committee;
- Cultural & Arts Advisory Committee;
- Heritage Committee;
- Senior Advisory Committee; and
- Youth Advisory Committee

There is no limit placed on the number of members appointed to these Committees. The purpose for seeking additional members for these Committees is to assist with meeting quorum, as well as creating greater diversity of members.

Comments

In accordance with the Policy, a Notice of Call for Applications was published in the Essex Free Press on August 29, 2019, and the Shoreline Week on August 30, 2019. Additionally, the Notice was posted on the Town's website and linked to the Town's social media accounts on Facebook and Twitter.

Committee Members were also notified of the call for Committee Appointments and encouraged to solicit new members.

The Policy establishes a deadline for submitting applications to the Clerk as October 31st annually.

Applicants must be:

- a resident, or owner/tenant of land in the Town;
- a Canadian citizen; and
- at least 18 years of age, unless otherwise indicated (i.e. Youth Advisory Committee members must be 13-23 years of age and Senior Advisory Committee members must be at least 60 years of age).

Applicants may not be:

- an employee of the Town, nor
- prohibited by law from voting in a municipal election.

A brief description of each of the Committees was provided in the earlier Report.

The Tables below provide a list of the current Committee Members and the names of the qualified applicants received before the October 31st deadline. The Tables also indicate the Committees to which Council Members have been appointed.
