Re: 2020 Windsor Line Replacement

Notice of Brushing and Vegetation Removal

As you are aware, Enbridge Gas Inc. is proposing to replace the majority of the existing Windsor Line natural gas pipeline with a new 6" pipeline. The proposed project will see the replacement of pipe between the intersection of Concession 8 and County Road 46 (Located in the Town of Tecumseh) and the existing Enbridge Gas Port Alma Transmission Station (located in the Municipality of Chatham-Kent) (see attached map for the general route). To support construction, it will be necessary to complete vegetation and tree clearing along the project route. The proposed clearing will occur primarily within municipal ROW with additional clearing on private lands were temporary work space is required at watercourse and road crossings.

By way of this letter, and to continue our past practice of keeping the Town of Tecumseh informed of proposed vegetation and tree clearing, Enbridge Gas Inc. would like to advise the Town of Tecumseh that as a result of the project, it will be necessary for Enbridge Gas Inc. and its Contractor to complete vegetation removal and select tree clearing for pipeline construction.

The majority of the vegetation removal and select tree clearing will commence approximately February 28, 2020 with a targeted completion date of March 31, 2020 to avoid the bat roosting and avian nesting seasons.

Compensation

Enbridge Gas's standard tree compensation program consists of a minimum 2:1 replacement for area removed based on 1000 seedlings per acre. Enbridge Gas Inc. will work with local Conservation Authorities and landowners to complete our compensation plan.
