Subject: Virtual Recreation Programming and Online Safety Policy

Recommendations

It is recommended:

That Report No. PRS-2020-19 respecting the Virtual Recreation Programming and Online Safety Policy, **be received**;

And that the Virtual Recreation Programming and Online Safety Policy, as appended to Report No. PRS-2020-19, **be approved**.

Background

As a result of the COVID-19 pandemic, the recreation sector has had to shift from its traditional methods of programming to re-think ways to provide recreational services to the residents of the community. Many municipalities and organizations have begun to offer virtual programs through websites, social media, telephone and video conferencing. Tecumseh Parks and Recreation has already begun to offer recreational programming through these methods including the introduction of the Virtual Recreation Complex page on the Town's website as well as posting links and videos on social media sites such as Facebook, Twitter and Instagram.

Comments

In an effort to continue to expand recreational programming, the Parks and Recreation Department plans to offer virtual recreation programming to allow for live and 'in-person' engagement with participants. Initial program plans include a Virtual Day Camp that will be led by Tecumseh Recreation summer students and will provide registered participants with

structured programming in the mornings and afternoons for the remainder of the summer. In addition, the Parks and Recreation Department will be engaging the services of third party service providers to offer programs such as Home Alone and Learn to Babysit.

To prepare for the implementation of virtual programming, the Tecumseh Parks and Recreation Department has drafted a Virtual Recreation Programming and Online Safety Policy (Attachment 1) that will guide the development and implementation of online recreational programming to ensure safety in the online environment.

The Virtual Recreation Programming and Online Safety Policy applies to any technological application where the Parks and Recreation Department team members are engaged in business activities in the performance of their roles within recreation programming, including but not limited to video conferencing applications such as Zoom, YouTube videos, Prerecorded videos and Live videos or streams.
