Dear Laura,

I wanted to take a moment of your time to express my anger and frustration with the Town in allowing a pot farm to be built near my home in Oldcastle. I feel betrayed and deceived that the Town chose to interpret the 1987 by-laws as allowing a greenhouse for the use of growing cannabis, rather than following the usual planning practice of requiring an amendment to the official plan, zoning by-laws, and public input. To me, this feels like a case of sneaky, dirty politics and it is a total disregard for the residence at this end of the municipality.
