Subject: Proposed Housekeeping Amendment to Sandwich South Zoning By-law 85-18

Although Mr. Mayor is quoted as saying 'I don't know of any municipality...that says you can grow corn but you can't grow wheat', his own municipality's outdated by-law says you can have a greenhouse but you can't grow mushrooms.
