



Two cars later raced around the roundabout at high speeds. Unfortunately these types of occurrences are not uncommon. I have also witnessed cars going the wrong way, picture attached. Has the council or any other party conducted a traffic study at the roundabout to determine what the traffic volume is during peak hours? Has a traffic study included Saturday morning through to Sunday evening? If not, as a community how can we possibly consider encouraging more youth, seniors and families to cross it? The traffic volume and potential dangers need to be studied before we can responsibly encourage more people to cross at the roundabout.


