We wish to advise you of our displeasure with the proposed Official Plan and Zoning Bylaw Amendments to the Victoria School property. There are virtually no significant changes to the Briday Proposal that was presented to us back in September of 2019 and the issues that were raised therein. None of our concerns regarding density, height, sewer capacity for the entire area or increased traffic to the area have been properly addressed. We are not opposed to development of that particular area but, we are adamantly opposed to the Briday proposal for the reasons stated herein. It appears that the council may have more concerns regarding Briday's needs and wants than it does for the taxpayers of this area. We implore council to designate the said area R1 much like they did with the old St. Anne's High School property. That too was a neighborhood that for all intents and purposes was and is according to Briday "a neighborhood with no character" This old northern Tecumseh neighborhood deserves the same consideration and respect that our Tecumseh neighborhoods to the south have received. Council has an obligation and duty to its constituents and their concerns, that's what our tax dollars pay for.
