Subject: Asphalt Paving Tender Award 2021

Recommendations

It is recommended:

That the low tender from Coco Paving Inc. in the amount of \$956,300 plus HST, for the 2021 Asphalt Paving Tender, **be approved** and that the Mayor and Clerk **be authorized** to enter into a contract for the services with Coco Paving Inc.

Background

At the December 8, 2020 Regular Meeting of Council, Council approved recommendations of Report No. PWES-2020-33 titled "Pre-Approval of 2021 Public Works & Environmental Services Capital Works Projects" that authorize Administration to proceed with the 2021 capital works projects including the Asphalt Program (Motion: 375/20).

The following streets were included in the 2021 Asphalt Program:

- 1. Baseline Rd, 11th Concession to City of Windsor
- 2. Estate Park, Talthorpe to Talthorpe
- 3. 8th Concession, CR46 to City of Windsor
- 4. Gauthier Drive, Little River to Cedarwood
- 5. Chene Court, Full Extent
- 6. Gouin Street, Herbert to Shawnee
- 7. Shawnee Road, Gouin Street to Maissoneuve
- 8. Lesperance Road, CR22 to Arbour
- 9. Green Valley Drive, Tecumseh to Meadowland
- 10. Harvest lane, Full Extent
- 11. St Gregory's Road, Manning to Green Valley

Comments

A tender call was advertised on the Town's website on February 2, 2021, along with being posted on the Town's bids and tenders account. Two (2) tender submissions were received on March 11, 2021 and were virtually opened in the presence of Administration and the Purchasing Officer.

Administration reviewed the tenders and all were found to be mathematically correct. The low tender contained no irregularities.

Administration therefore recommends that the low tender from Coco Paving Inc. in the amount of \$956,300 plus HST, for the 2021 Asphalt Paving Tender, be approved and that the Mayor and Clerk be authorized to enter into contract for the services with Coco Paving Inc.

Financial Implications

Council approved an allocation of \$1,100,000 for the 2021 asphalt paving work as recommended within Report No. PWES-2020-33. It should be noted that the tender submitted by Coco Paving Inc. does include \$50,000 in provisional costs for items such as asphalt escalation. It should also be noted that the tender is based on estimated quantities. The final actual costs will be determined based on actual quantities required. Every attempt will be made to keep the expenditures within the allocated amount of \$1,100,000.
