
Background

This Report summarizes the permits issued for the first six months of 2021 (January-June) and compares the values of the same period of the previous year.


1. Construction Value:

The following chart summarizes the reported construction value of permits for the period. Construction value was reported at \$54,205,909, which is up by \$46,255,814 or 581 percent over last year. This is due in part to the construction of two multi storey apartment buildings that have a combined value of \$28,000,000 and an industrial/office building with a value of \$5,600,000.



2. Number of Permits:

The following chart summarizes the total number of permits issued for the period. A total of 148 permits were issued which is a decrease of 8 permits or 5 percent over the previous year.



3. Permit Types:

The following chart summarizes permits issued by type for the period. Some significant permits are 9 single unit dwellings, 2 multi storey apartment buildings creating 142 dwelling units and 3 industrial buildings. There are also 8 backwater valve permits issued for the period.
