

The Corporation of the Town of Tecumseh

By-Law Number 2022-003

Being a by-law to authorize the execution of a Service Agreement between The Corporation of the Town of Tecumseh and the City of Windsor to administer funds for the Pathway to Potential Program for the year 2021.

Whereas The Corporation of the Town of Tecumseh (Town) has entered into a one-year Service Agreement with the City of Windsor for the Pathway to Potential (P2P) Program since 2013, to administer funding to assist low income families with access to recreation programs;

And whereas the P2P Program is designed to align with the Ontario government's Poverty Reduction Strategy to reduce poverty, mobilize the community to promote awareness, and engage the development and implementation of strategies to reduce the poverty rates in Windsor and Essex County;

And whereas the Town desires to enter into a Service Agreement with the City of Windsor to administer the funds under the P2P Program for the year 2021;

And whereas under Section 5 of the *Municipal Act 2001*, S.O. 2001 c.25, the powers of a municipality shall be exercised by its Council by by-law.

Now Therefore the Council of The Corporation of The Town of Tecumseh enacts as follows:

1. **That** the Mayor and the Clerk be and hereby authorized and empowered on behalf of The Corporation of the Town of Tecumseh, to execute a Service Agreement between The Corporation of the Town of Tecumseh and the City of Windsor commencing January 1, 2021 for the provision of providing funds to administer the Pathway to Potential Program, a copy of which the Service Agreement is attached as Schedule A hereto and forms part of this by-law and to do such further and other acts which may be necessary to implement the said Service Agreement.
2. **And That** this by-law shall come into force and take effect upon on the date of the third and final reading.

Read a first, second, third time and finally passed this 25th day of January, 2022.
