

The Corporation of the Town of Tecumseh

By-Law Number 2022-025

Being a by-law to authorize the execution of an Agreement between The Corporation of the Town of Tecumseh and the Canadian Urban Institute for funding under the My Main Street Community Activator Program.

Whereas the Federal Economic Development Agency for Southern Ontario (FedDev) has developed the Southern Ontario Prosperity Program (SOPP), which is intended to stimulate economic activity in neighbourhoods across Ontario by supporting small and medium sized enterprises in southern Ontario;

And Whereas the Canadian Urban Institute (CUI) has entered into an agreement with FedDev for the implementation of the SOPP through the My Main Street Community Activator Program (MMS Program);

And Whereas the MMS Program supports the recovery from the pandemic across southern Ontario by revitalizing main streets and facilitating the return of locally owned independent businesses;

And Whereas the Town has applied to CUI to participate in the MMS Program and was approved to receive funds for 100th Anniversary Celebration Community Mural (Project);

And Whereas the Town is desirous of entering into a Recipient Agreement with CUI for the funding of the Project;

And Whereas pursuant to the *Municipal Act*, S.O. 2001, c.25 the powers of a municipality shall be exercised by by-law.

Now Therefore the Council of The Corporation of The Town of Tecumseh enacts as follows:

1. **That** the Mayor and Clerk be authorized and empowered to execute an Agreement between The Corporation of the Town of Tecumseh and Canadian Urban Institute for funding under the My Main Street Community Activator Program, a copy of which Agreement is attached hereto and forms part of the By-law and to do such further and other acts which may be necessary to implement the said Agreement.
2. **That** this By-law shall come into force and take effect on 7th day of April 2022.

Read a first, second, third time and finally passed this 7th day of April, 2022.
