Subject: Asphalt Paving Tender Award 2022

Recommendations

It is recommended:

That the low tender from Coco Paving Inc. in the amount of \$997,750 plus HST, for the 2022 Asphalt Paving Tender, **be approved** and that the Mayor and Clerk **be authorized** to enter into a contract for the services with Coco Paving Inc.

Background

At the January 25, 2022 Regular Meeting of Council, Council approved recommendations of Report No. PWES-2022-03 titled "Approval of 2022 Public Works & Engineering Services Capital Works Projects" that authorize Administration to proceed with the 2022 capital works projects including the 2022 Asphalt Program (Motion: RCM-23/22).

The following streets were included in the 2022 Asphalt Program:

- 1) Riverside Drive. Arlington to Kensington
- 2) Poisson Street, Tecumseh Road to Arbour
- 3) Piccadilly Avenue, Full Extent
- 4) Trafalgar Court, Full Extent
- 5) Green Valley Drive, Meadowland to Brunelle
- 6) Verdant Court, Full Extent
- 7) Maisonneuve Street, St. Anne to Lesperance

8) Intersection Road, Lesperance to Shawnee

Comments

A tender call was advertised on the Town's website on March 31, 2022, along with being posted on the Town's bids and tenders account. Two (2) tender submissions were received on April 14, 2022 and were virtually opened in the presence of Administration and the Purchasing Officer.

Administration reviewed the tenders and all were found to be mathematically correct. The low tender contained no irregularities.

Administration therefore recommends that the low tender from Coco Paving Inc. in the amount of \$997,750 plus HST, for the 2022 Asphalt Paving Tender, be approved and that the Mayor and Clerk be authorized to enter into contract for the services with Coco Paving Inc.

Financial Implications

Council approved an allocation of \$1,100,000 for the 2022 asphalt paving work as recommended within Report No. PWES-2022-03. It should be noted that the tender submitted by Coco Paving Inc. does include \$50,000 in provisional costs for items such as asphalt escalation. It should also be noted that the tender is based on estimated quantities and that the price of asphalt cement has escalated in the recent months. The final actual costs will be determined based on actual quantities required. Every attempt will be made to keep the expenditures within the allocated amount of \$1,100,000.

The low tender provided by Coco Paving Inc. of \$997,750 plus HST, inclusive of the \$50,000 contingency amount is below the approved allocation.
