

Frequently Asked Questions:

What are the costs for the program?

Tree with 100th anniversary plaque - \$850 A tax receipt will be issued to you for income tax purposes

What type of tree species do you offer?

The program currently offer the following tree species: Honeylocust, Kentucky Coffeetree, London Plane Tree, Native Red Maple and Silver Maple.

What are the terms?

Commemorative trees become the property of the Town and will be considered a donation by the contributor. The tree will be maintained in the same manner as other trees in Town parks. The Town will be responsible to replace the tree on one (1) occasion within the first five (5) years.

Where can the tree be placed?

Several locations are available throughout the Town. Please contact the Parks and Recreation Office to inquire whether your preferred location is available.

What happens if the tree or plaque is damaged or vandalized?

The Town will maintain the tree's basic integrity in the same manner as other municipal trees, but will not be liable for damages incurred by circumstances beyond its control [such as acts of vandalism, wear and tear, weather deterioration, etc.]. Replacement or repair costs to the custom plaque, if desired, will be the responsibility of the contributor.

Who owns the tree and do I have exclusive rights to it?

The tree remains the sole property of the Town of Tecumseh, and becomes part of the parks system for all to enjoy.

When will the tree be planted and plaques be installed?

Order must be placed no later than October 1 of each year to quality for planting by November of the same year. Reasonable efforts will be made to install the tree and plaque within 60 days of order confirmation, weather permitting.
