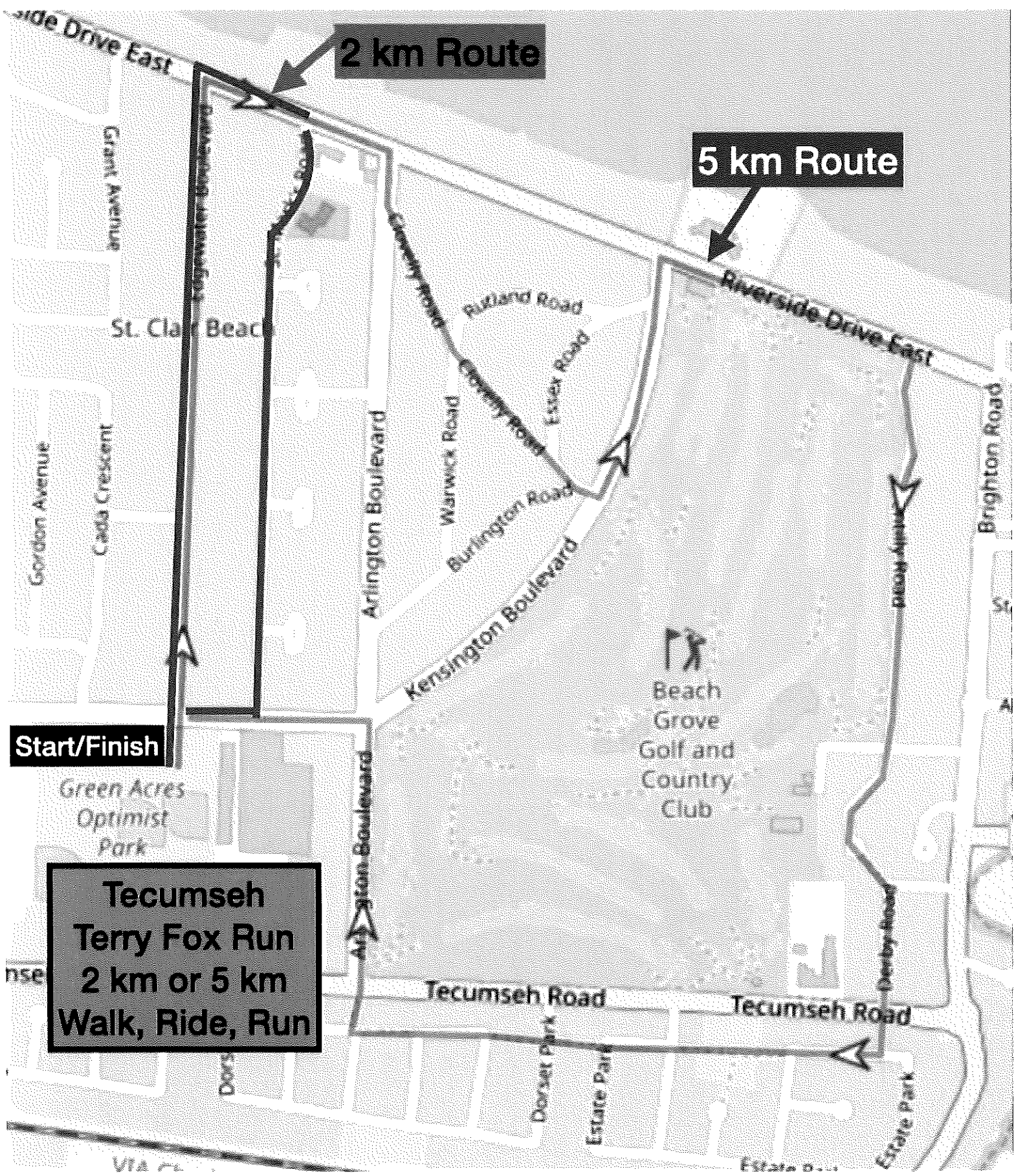

**2022 Cat Spay and Neuter Voucher Program  
Phase II**

The Town of Tecumseh, in partnership with local veterinary hospitals/clinics, is pleased to announce **Phase II** of the **2022 Cat Spay and Neuter Voucher Program** (Program). Phase II of the Program will begin **Thursday, September 22, 2022** and is available to residents of the Town of Tecumseh, only.

In an effort to reduce the number of feral cats in the Town, Vouchers (valued at \$50 each) that were not redeemed during Phase I of the 2022 Program will be carried over to Phase II.

A limited number of Vouchers are available. For feral cat caregivers, a maximum of five (5) Vouchers will be issued with no income restrictions.

Applications for Phase II of the 2022 Program are to be completed and submitted online via the Town's website. Vouchers will be issued electronically via email. Please note that Vouchers are issued on a first come, first serve basis, and will expire on December 1, 2022.

## TECUMSEH 2022 MUNICIPAL AND SCHOOL BOARD ELECTIONS

Tecumseh, ON - The Town of Tecumseh will conduct Municipal & School Board Elections using the **Internet and Telephone Voting methods.**

Look for your **Voter Information Letter** in your mailbox.

Tecumseh electors, on the Voters' List, were mailed a Voter Information Letter (VIL) on September 26, 2022, which includes their Personal Identification Number (PIN) and voting instructions.

If you have not yet received your VIL by October 14, 2022, please contact the Tecumseh Election Hotline at 519-735-2743.

**Be sure to check your mailbox and to keep your VIL in a safe location until the voting period commences.**

### Voting Period

Voting will **begin** Friday, October 14 at 8:30 am and will **end on Election Day**, Monday, October 24 at 8:00 pm online at [tecumsehvotes.ca](https://tecumsehvotes.ca) or using the Telephone number provided in your VIL.

### Need Assistance?

**Voter Information Centres** will be offered to assist eligible electors with voting, obtaining a VIL if they have not voted or amending their Voter Information. The Voter Information Centres will offer electors a computer, iPad or telephone to cast their votes, during the following times:

10:00 am - 12:00 pm

Election Day: October 24  
8:30 am - 8:00 pm

#### Maidstone Recreation Centre

Eligible voters who are inside Town Hall after 8:00 pm on Election Day, will only be able to vote using Town computers. All other Internet and Telephone voting will cease at 8:00 pm.
