A Member inquired clarification on the School Crossing Guards and the next steps moving forward after the decision at the May 13, 2024, Regular Council Meeting. The CAO advises there has been administrative action since Council's direction as the Director People & Culture has contacted schools and school boards, a contract has been signed in regards to the study on the school safety zones to commence. The CAO added that Administration is looking into the St. Thomas school crossing guard location as a Councillor has raised some concern and Administration is reviewing the data. The lay off notices have been sent out to the school crossing guards for the end of June, which is standard practice.

A Member requests that Administration contact the County to review of the intersection at Baseline and 11th Concession Roads to determine if an additional stop sign can be added.
