

The Corporation of the Town of Tecumseh

By-Law Number 2025-003

Being a by-law to amend By-law 2024-097 being a by-law to prescribe a tariff of administrative fees and charges for the Town of Tecumseh for 2025

Whereas Section 391 of *The Municipal Act, 2001 S.O. 2001, c. M.25* authorizes a municipality to impose fees or charges on persons for services or activities provided or done by or on behalf of it; for costs payable by it for services or activities provided or done by or on behalf of any other municipality or any local board; and for the use of its property including property under its control;

And whereas *The Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, C. M25* grants a municipality the power to pass by-laws that impose specific fees for licensing, services, permits and other reasons;

And whereas Section 446(1) of *The Municipal Act S. O. 2001, c.M.25* authorizes a municipality under this or any other Act or under a bylaw under this or any other Act to direct or require a person to do a matter or thing, the municipality may also provide that, in default of it being done by the person directed or required to do it, the matter or thing shall be done at the person's expense;

And whereas the Council of The Corporation of the Town of Tecumseh deems it desirous to prescribe administrative fees and charges for The Corporation of the Town of Tecumseh, not otherwise prescribed by by-law.

Now Therefore the Council of The Corporation of The Town of Tecumseh enacts as follows:

1. **That** By-Law 2024-097 be amended by deleting its Schedule A General Administration, Schedule B Community Safety, and Schedule C Police Services in its entirety and replacing same with the amended Schedule A General Administration, Schedule B Community Safety, and Schedule C Police Services attached hereto and forming part of this by-law and to do such further and other act which may be necessary to implement the Schedule A, B, and C.
2. **That** any by-law(s) inconsistent with this by-law are hereby repealed.

Read a first, second, third time and finally passed this 28th day of January, 2025.
