2ND BITE BY SAME DOG. BIT WIFE IN MAY 2024 AS WELL. WAS WALKING HIS DOG ON LEASH DOWN LITTLE RIVER, HUSKY WAS RUNNING TOWARDS US ON ROAD. CAR STARTED HONKING HORN TO TRY AND WARN HIM. HE TURNED AROUND AND THE DOG ATTEMPTED TO ATTACK HIS DOG. HE GOT BETWEEN THE DOGS AND WAS BIT ON LEFT FOREARM CAUSING SCAPES AND 2 PUNCTURE WOUNDS, OWNER'S OF HUSKY WERE OUT LOOKING FOR THE DOG AND TOOK OFF WHEN HE SAW THE OWNER'S COMING. ATTENDED TMC CLINIC IN TECUMSEH WHERE HE RECEIVED ANTIBIOTICS.

Dunbar Bite Severity Scale

Low severity incident	Level 1	Dog growls, lunges, snarls-no teeth touch skin. Mostly intimidation/threatening behaviour
	Level 2	Teeth touch skin but no puncture. May have red mark/minor bruise from dogs head or snout. May have minor scratches from paws/nails. Minor surface abrasions or lacerations.
Medium severity incident	Level 3	Punctures one to three holes, single bite. No tearing or slashes. Victim not shaken side to side. Bruising
High severity incident	Level 3.5	Multiple level 3 bites
	Level 4	Two to four holes from a single bite, typically contact/punctures from more than canines, considerable bruising. Black bruising, tears and/or slashing wounds. Dog clamped down and held and/or shook head from side to side.
	Level 5	Multiple bites at level 4 or above. A concerted repeated attack causing sever injury.
	Level 6	Any bite resulting in death of an animal.

Dog Bite Incident - October 21, 2024

I was walking my son's dog along Litte River Blvd at approximately 6:30 pm between Woodridge Drive and Centennial Drive. At that location an unleashed large Husky came from behind us and attacked my son's dog. In order to try to protect my son's dog, who was on a leash, I put myself between the two dogs, which then prompted the Husky to bite me a couple of times on my left forearm resulting in some puncture wounds to my arm. After a few minutes, the Husky dog owner pulled up in a small SUV and her son attempted to capture the Husky. To avoid capture, the Husky proceeded north on Centennial Drive at which point I lost site of the dog. Two motorists who where passing by stopped to check on me and my son's dog to make sure we were OK. Unfortunately, the Husky dog owner left the scene without saying a word to me - after witnessing the end of this attack and the results! This was our second encounter with this particular dog. My wife and I were walking our son's dog on St. Thomas Street in Tecumseh in early May when that same, unleashed, Husky dog attempted to attack our son's dog, who my wife had on the leash. This attack resulted in several wounds on my wife's arm, hand and legs, which required a hospital ER visit where she had to receive several stitches in her hand to close up the wound.

I have attached pictures of both incidents. The first two pictures are from the most recent attack and the final three pictures are from May when my wife was attacked.

I went into the garage, but the door between the garage and house did not click shut unbeknownst to me. Neo (husky) quickly ran out in the street. My son and I jumped in my car to retrieve Neo. Neo did not obey our calling commands, so we followed him in the car closely, while my teenage son would jump out of the car with a leash in hopes of retrieving the dog. After about 5 minutes, the dog spotted a man with what it seemed like a terrier/pitbull mix at the north corner of Centennial and Little River. The man's dog was very aggressive and attacked Neo. Neo did not back down. At this point (about 20 seconds later) the man tried to get in between them, while my son crossed the street to restrain Neo. When Neo saw my son, he bolted off. For the next 15 mins we chased Neo while he passed many people and dogs and just like usual, he never approached any of them. Finally we caught him in a neighbour's yard. Please note that

the man with the dog did not seem to have gotten bitten while we tried to break up the dogs. It is a lot more likely, based on the aggressive nature of his dog, that his dog bit him - if he claims a bite. We have never had any aggression, from Neo towards any people. To me it seems like a neighbour's personal grudge than an act that the dog actually performed. Neo is very mild natured, he has all his shots, regular vet visits, frequents the dog park regularly (other than now-on his 10-day quarantine), and has gone through obedience training. In our family, he plays with other animals and young children without concern. Please contact me if you have further questions.
