I am a resident of Lakeshore, but my grandparents have been residents of St. Clair Beach for more than 50 years and I spend a great deal of time with them.

As a member of the younger generation, I am concerned about the implications of adding fluoride to the drinking water. Although it could be beneficial in the prevention of dental carries, the long-term effects of hydrofluorosilicic acid on human health has not been adequately studied.

Until such time that studies have been conducted on the long-term health implications of water fluoridation through the addition of hydrofluorosilicic acid, I believe that the Tecumseh Town Council should not make the decision to add this substance to our water supply based on a single report given by the local health unit that examines only the oral health impact of water fluoridation.

I urge the Tecumseh Town Council to be forward-thinking, and to consider the gravity of the decision about water fluoridation and its impact on the long-term health of the residents of Windsor/Essex County.
