

# The Corporation of the Town of Tecumseh

## By-Law Number 2019-17

Being a by-law to authorize the execution of a Letter of Agreement between The Corporation of the Town of Tecumseh and Her Majesty the Queen in Right of Ontario as represented by the Minister of Transportation for Ontario relating to funding under the Dedicated Gas Tax Funds for Public Transportation program

**Whereas** the Province of Ontario established a Dedicated Gas Tax Fund for Public Transportation Program to increase public transportation ridership to support the development of strong communities;

**And Whereas** funding to municipalities by the Minister of Transportation for the Province of Ontario (MTO) will be provided in accordance with the terms and conditions set out in a Letter of Agreement and the Dedicated Gas Tax Funds for Public Transportation Program 2018/2019 Guidelines and Requirements;

**And Whereas** the Council of The Corporation of the Town of Tecumseh is desirous of entering into a Letter of Agreement for the provision of funding under the Dedicated Gas Tax Funds for Public Transportation Program, aligning the program year with the Provincial fiscal year, running from April 1, 2018 to March 31, 2019;

**And Whereas** under Section 5 of the Municipal Act 2001, S.O. 2001 c.25, the powers of a municipality shall be exercised by its Council by by-law.

**Now Therefore the Council of The Corporation of The Town of Tecumseh Enacts as follows:**

1. **That** the Mayor and Director Financial Services & Treasurer be and they are hereby authorized and empowered on behalf of The Corporation of the Town of Tecumseh, to execute a Letter of Agreement between The Corporation of the Town of Tecumseh and Her Majesty the Queen in Right of Ontario as represented by the Minister of Transportation for the Province of Ontario, a copy of which Letter of Agreement is attached hereto and forms part of this by-law and to do such further and other acts which may be necessary to implement the said Letter of Agreement for the provision of funding under the Dedicated Gas Tax Funds for Public Transportation Program for 2018/2019.
2. **That** this by-law shall come into force and take effect upon on the date of the third and final reading thereof.

**Read** a first, second and third time and finally passed this 26th day of February, 2019.
