Recommendations

It is recommended:

1. **That** an off-road, multipurpose pathway extending from County Road 42 to County Road 22 **be endorsed** as a candidate project for funding through the Investing in Canada Infrastructure Program (ICIP), in accordance with the details and funding requirements identified in PBS-2019-13.

Background

Council, at its May 14, 2019 Regular Meeting of Council received PBS-2019-13 (see Attachment 1). This report introduced an off-road, multipurpose pathway extending from County Road 42 to County Road 22 as a candidate project for funding through the Investing in Canada Infrastructure Program (ICIP). Within this report, specific details regarding the ICIP funding requirements along with the rationale for the proposed candidate project were provided.

The report recommended that, based on the feedback received at the May 14, 2019 Regular Meeting of Council, Administration bring forward a future report to Council on May 28, 2019 recommending the direction forward for this project.

Comments

At the May 14, 2019 meeting, Council provided positive feedback and expressed support for the proposed candidate project.
