The Corporation of the Town of Tecumseh By-Law Number 2019-65

Being a by-law to authorize the execution of Transfer Payment Agreement with Her Majesty the Queen in right of Ontario as represented by the Minister of Municipal Affairs and Housing and The Corporation of the Town of Tecumseh under the National Disaster Mitigation Program

Whereas the Government of Canada (Canada) established the National Disaster Mitigation Program (NDMP) to support projects that contribute to the reduction of the impacts of natural disasters on Canadians;

AND WHEREAS The Corporation of the Town of Tecumseh (Town) has been allocated Funds from the NDMP for improvements to the Scully and St. Marks Storm Pump Station and P.J. Cecile Storm Pump Station (Projects);

AND WHEREAS Minister of Municipal Affairs and Housing, an agent of Her Majesty the Queen in right of Ontario (Minister), will be administering the NDMP in the Province of Ontario;

AND WHEREAS the Town is desirous of entering into an Agreement with the Minister which sets out the terms and conditions upon which NDMP funds will be provided to the Town for the purpose of carrying out the Projects;

AND WHEREAS pursuant to the *Municipal Act*, S.O. 2001, c.25 s.5(3), the powers of a municipality shall be exercised by by-law;

Now Therefore the Council of The Corporation of The Town of Tecumseh Enacts as follows:

- 1. That the Mayor and the Clerk be and they are hereby authorized and empowered on behalf of The Corporation of the Town of Tecumseh, to execute a Transfer Payment Agreement with Her Majesty the Queen in right of Ontario as represented by the Minister of Municipal Affairs and Housing, a copy of which Transfer Payment Agreement is attached hereto and forms part of this By-law and to do such further and other acts which may be necessary to implement the said Transfer Payment Agreement;
- 2. **That** this By-law shall come into full force and take effect on the date the third and final reading thereof.

Read a first, second and third time and finally passed this 10th day of September, 2019.
